

BOOK BAGS AND READING BOOKS



CLASS 1

BOOTS IN SCHOOL

In the winter pupils who come to school wearing boots should change into indoor shoes or plimsolls in school. They may, of course, change into their PE trainers to save sending another pair of shoes to school.

ATTENDANCE

Our attendance target for the new school year is 96%. Any pupil with below 90% attendance will be deemed a Persistent Absentee under DfE guidelines.

If your child is unwell and unable to attend school we will need you to evidence this. Our attendance figures dropped significantly last term and the Local Authority Attendance Officer is keeping a close eye on us! If you text your child's absence with a description of what is wrong we can print a copy or you could write a short note or send an email. If children need a doctor's appointment or have a hospital appointment a copy of the hospital letter or doctor's appointment card can be used for evidence. If children are on medication the medicine box will be fine as evidence of absence due to illness. Please help keep our attendance up both this term and next.

HOLIDAYS IN TERM TIME

Please remember we cannot authorise ANY holidays in term time and any holiday absence will be recorded as UNAUTHORISED.

D & V OUTBREAKS

Tummy bugs, sickness and flu spread very easily at this time of year. Public Health Advice states "Children who fall ill with sickness and diarrhoea should not return to school until 48 hours after they were last sick or had diarrhoea." Our aim, with this advice, is to prevent illness spreading within schools and causing more families distress. Please also remember if you have a well child with a sick sibling the well child should attend school.

If you have any difficulties getting a child to school when a sibling is ill please let us know and we will do all we can to help.
