We are very proud of the results achieved this year.
The published data shows that we are performing at least in line*
or better than National expectations in in Early Years, Year 1
phonics.

*It should be noted that small cohorts mean that just above or just below National figures indicate that the school is generally in line with national. In some cohorts one child could equate to as much as 20% or 25%.
